

## Definitions: Cannabis Basics Terminology

BHO Butane hash oil, also referred to as butane honey oil. A concentrate obtained by using n-Butane as a solvent. **budtender** A dispensary employee who works in a cannabis storefront and educates consumers about the effects, benefits, and overall experience of cannabis products. cannabinoid Compounds found in the cannabis plant that affect the endocannabinoid system. chlorophyll A pigment found in green plants that absorbs light for photosynthesis. **concentrate** Concentrated essential oil of a plant obtained through extraction. Also called extract. dab Highly concentrated extract of cannabis that is vaporized and inhaled using a dab rig. dioecious A plant that has male and female sex characteristics in separate individuals. **distillate** A concentrate that has been purified through an extensive refinement process that separates its components. **edible** Cannabis-infused products that are fit for humans to eat. **flower** The dried flowers (buds) of the cannabis plant. Cannabis plants that are primarily used for industrial purposes. As hemp per United States federal law, the THC concentration of hemp may be no higher than 0.3%. hybrid Plant produced by careful pollination of two specific varieties to

bring together desired traits. Hybrid seeds do not typically produce

the same variety of cannabis as the parent plants.

indica Variety of cannabis with a short stature, short flowering period, and sedative effect. **isolate** A substance in an uncombined or pure state. **lipid** A fatty acid that is not soluble in water but is soluble in organic solvents (natural oils and waxes). Strength of an intoxicant as measured by the amount required to potency elicit a certain response. rosin Cannabis extract created with heat and pressure rather than solvents. **RSO** An unrefined, potent cannabis oil extracted using ethanol as a solvent. sativa Variety of cannabis with a tall stature, long flowering period, and energizing effect. **solvent** A liquid chemical used to extract the essential oils from a plant by dissolving them. **strain** A variety of a plant developed by breeding. sublingual Administered under the tongue. terpene Volatile, unsaturated hydrocarbons found in plant essential oils that are used in flavorings and fragrances. Provides aroma and flavor to cannabis and other plants. **trichome** A unicellular and glandular hair or growth on the skin of a plant that
