Note: Light, heat, and oxygen are the main culprits when it comes to degradation of cannabinoids in cannabis flower. All cannabis products should be stored in a cool, dry, dark place to avoid cannabinoid degradation.

Glycerin tincture	Tightly sealed in a glass jar	1 year	1 year	—
Bubble hash	Dry fully, then store in parchment, silicone, or glass	indefinitely	—	—
Rick Simpson Oil	In a syringe or a silicone container	indefinitely	—	—
Concentrates	In silicone, parchment, or glass Use by expiration date	Expiration date on package	Expiration date on package	Expiration date on package
