

## Procedure: How To Trim Cannabis By Hand

Use this procedure to trim cannabis plants after harvest. You can trim your plants before or after you dry them.

- Set up a clean, dry trimming area with lots of light.
- Start with clean, sharp snips, and a fresh pair of gloves.
- If your plants have not yet been dried, cut the stem from the plant, leaving the roots in the dirt.
- Wet Plants: Leave the stem attached to the buds so you have something to use as a hangar during the drying process.

  Dry Plants: Cut the buds from the stem.
- Remove any remaining large leaves from the plant.
- Wet Plants: Remove the small sugar leaves from the buds, as well as the small stem they are attached to.

**Dry Plants**: Trim the sugar leaves so that they are even with the buds.

Wet Plants: Cut the stems into manageable pieces, leaving nodes at the ends to use as hooks.

**Dry Plants**: Cut the flowers to a size that will fit well in a jar for curing.

Use 91% or higher isopropyl alcohol to regularly clean your scissors, throughout the process and at the end for storage.
