



Procedure:

How To Make Rosin At Home

Use this method to create a 7 to 12% return of dabbable, solvent-free cannabis oil with a potency as high as 75%.

1

Gather these supplies:

- Hair straightening iron (one with adjustable heating levels is preferred)
- Parchment paper
- At least 1 gram of dried cannabis flower, kief, or bubble hash
- Razor blade or dabbing tool
- Heat-resistant gloves

Fold a piece of the parchment paper in half and put some cannabis in the middle.

Set the straightening iron to the lowest setting (280 to 330°F, 138 to 165°C).

Put on the heat-resistant gloves.

Place the parchment paper between the irons and apply a lot of pressure. If possible, use clamps. Apply pressure for about five seconds if you're using flower, or up to 15 seconds if you're using kief or bubble hash.

Open the paper and iron and check the bud. If finished, it should be brown or darkish green, and flat. If it's not, repeat the process, using more pressure when you press the irons together.

When finished, remove the parchment paper from the hair straightening iron and take off the heat-resistant gloves.

Allow the rosin to cool, and then scrape it off the parchment paper with a razor blade or a dabbing tool.
